Over 10,000 reports have been filed since May 2014. Reports are sent to legislators and Navy quarterly.

In four years of asking for mitigation of Growler noise only two actions have occurred: 1) A schedule of Field Carrier Landing Practice which is changed often and almost never updated, 2) A requirement to fly over the San Juan's with gear-up. Gear-up reduces the noise. This appears to be happening about half the time.

Since mitigation does not seem possible, Quiet Skies and groups across our region are asking for Growler re-location.
